## COVER VS NO COVER

Depending on your container, you may be able to cover your terrarium. I only suggest to use a cover if your plant can sustain very, very, high temperatures or if you are planting moss. If you do decide to use a cover, remember to uncover your terrarium every 2-3 days to avoid algae and smell build up.



## WHERE TO PLACE YOUR PLANTS

Place your terrarium in sunny areas in your home. Succulents LOVE the sun and warm areas. But in a glass or clear container, direct sunlight will be *too hot* for your plants. So place them in areas with indirect sunlight. Keep them in a place at room temperature. To keep them cool, on really hot days, I usually close all the windows around them or turn on a ceiling fan.



## HOW TO WATER SUCCULENTS

Succulents are known for not needing to be watered as frequently as other plants. But that does not mean that they do not need water! To water your terrarium, fill it with water (at least 3/4 of the space) once a week for your plants. Or you can water your plants when the soil is completely dried out. In the winter or cooler months, your plants will only need some watering once every month.



## MAINTAINING PLANT HEALTH

Remove dead leaves from terrarium when you see them. Spray your plants' leaves once every week or every other week. Spray bug or pesticides if you start to see bugs roam around the terrarium. If possible mix soil, once a month, around for good airflow to the plants. And try to clean out the inner and over parts of the terrarium.
